Parentmail issue with BT Internet accounts

We have been informed that parentmails are not getting to 'btinternet.com' email addresses. This is due to BT introducing new spam filters and many different emails, including those from parentmail are ending up in the account holder's SPAM folder rather than their inbox.

To resolve this issue, BT have advised that users need to create 'rules' on their account to redirect the emails into their inbox. Go to 'Actions'; 'create rule'.

Then you need to create a rule where 'sender is': info@parentmail.co.uk; 'move to folder': inbox

And Save.
