Aylmerton 2018 Residential Final Reminders

Dear Parents/Carers,

Just a few reminders for the Aylmerton Residential:

Travel arrangements - Departure Monday 22nd October 2018

The coach has been booked to leave school at 9:00am on Monday 22nd October 2018. Please bring your child's luggage into the hall at **8:30am**, staff will be available to book children in.

Travel arrangements - Arrival home on Friday 26th October 2018

We intend to leave Aylmerton at around 1.00pm on the Friday, so we should be back at school at approximately 4:00pm. We will update you via ParentMail text message during the day.

Packed lunch for Monday 22nd October 2018

Children will need a packed lunch and drinks bottle (no fizzy drinks) in a small backpack to be kept with them, as all luggage will be packed away in the coach boot. The back pack will be used during the week along with their drinks bottle. Children will be able to refill their drinks bottle with water for the day's activities during the week.

Medicines

Unfortunately, we are **only** able to administer prescribed medicines whilst on a residential. Any **prescribed medicines** that children will need administering during the trip, need to be placed in a clear plastic bag clearly marked with the child's name and dosage information. It must also be accompanied by the signed 'medicines form' (form is attached). The form and medicine bag will need to be handed to Mrs Darlison on the Monday morning as part of the booking in process. If your child suffers from a recurrent illness, for example migraines, and could need medication during the week, it would be a good idea to speak to your doctor and get a prescription. Please note that Mrs Darlison will have some hard copies of the medicines form on the Monday, but it would be helpful if you could fill it in in advance to save time on the morning.

Medical Details and Dietary Requirements

Thank you for completing the medical details and dietary requirements for your child. If since completing these forms, anything has changed, please inform the school office as a matter of urgency.

Luggage

If at all possible, it would be a lot easier if your child had a wheeled case/holdall as luggage. Please check your child can move their luggage, as they will need to move it from the car park to the centre!

Pocket Money

There is little need or opportunity to spend money during our trip. There is an opportunity to buy small souvenirs/drinks and snacks at the disco on the last night. If you would like to send your child with pocket money, we would recommend a maximum of £5. This should be placed securely in a purse or wallet **with the child's name marked on it**. This should be handed over to Mrs Darlison in the hall on the Monday morning and will be passed over to your child on the night of the disco.

Reminder – **no sweets/snacks**

Please note that no sweets or snacks should be brought in luggage for the dorms due to health and safety reasons.

Clothing

You will have received the recommended kit list already – please contact the office if not. As a general reminder, your child will need to have lots of layers for each day, a waterproof coat and waterproof trousers if possible.

Labelling clothes/personal items

We stress the need for all of the children's clothes and personal items to be named. We would like to return with **NO LOST PROPERTY!** It would also be useful to add a couple of plastic bags into their suitcases so that they can put any wet/dirty clothes into them as needed.

Indoor footwear

Please send a pair of indoor shoes, (trainers are not allowed inside the lounges and bedrooms). Please do not send novelty slippers or slipper boots as these are too slippery for the floors. Plimsolls or indoor pumps/hard slippers only please.

No swimming kit needed

We will not be going swimming during our week, so a swimming kit is not needed.

Important – no cameras please

Please note that no cameras of any sort are allowed to be taken on the trip.
